

SUNDAY READING

First Reading (Acts 5:12-16). This is a summary of the life and power of the primitive Christian community in Jerusalem. The ministry of the Church, like that of Jesus, is characterized by the power of healing.

Second Reading (Rev. 1:9-13, 17-19). John, having suffered for the faith, and now in exile, has a wonderful vision of Jesus who is now in glory after his victory over sin and death. With this vision the intense religious insights of the book of the Apocalypse begin and build up to the climax where the whole creation sings the praises of the Lamb.

Gospel (John 20:19-31). The risen Lord bestows on the disciples the gifts of peace, the Holy Spirit, and the power to forgive sin. Thomas confesses his faith in the Risen Lord.


